WHAT'S NEW

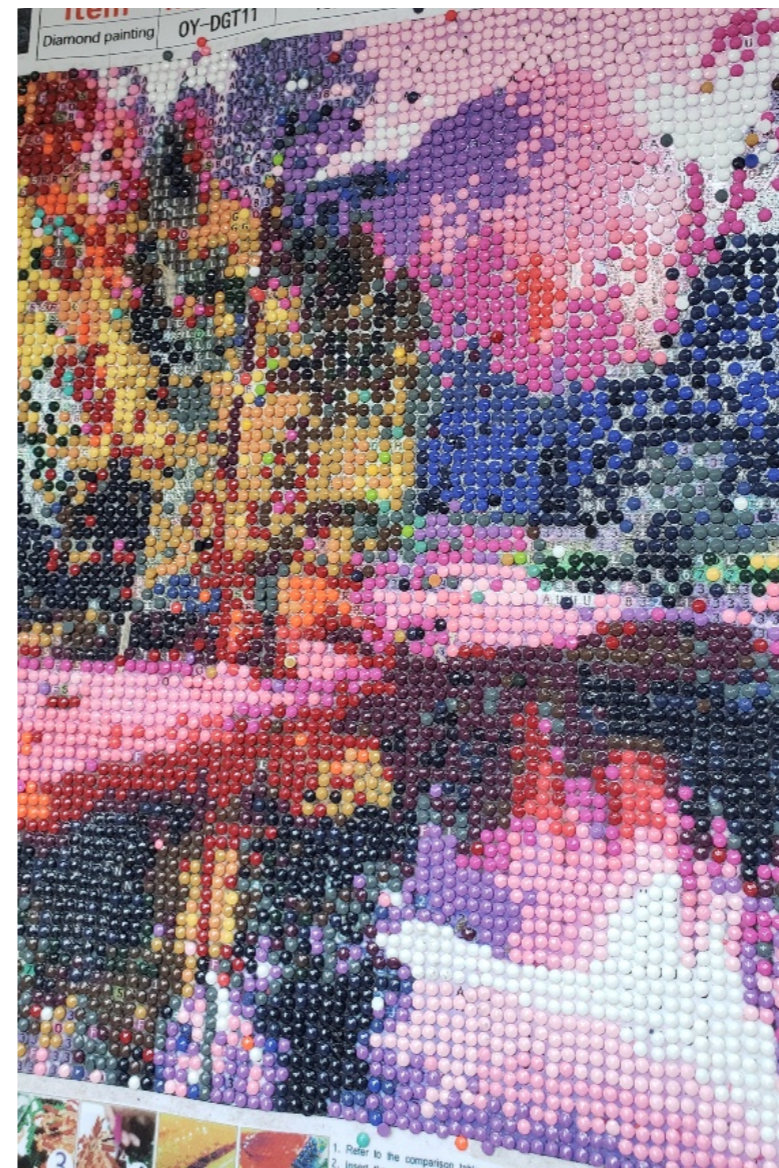
Jazlin continues to spend many hours completing diamond bead paintings - very large ones.

Jazlin likes to draw from step by step instructions - cartoon style. Here is one example in the slide show.

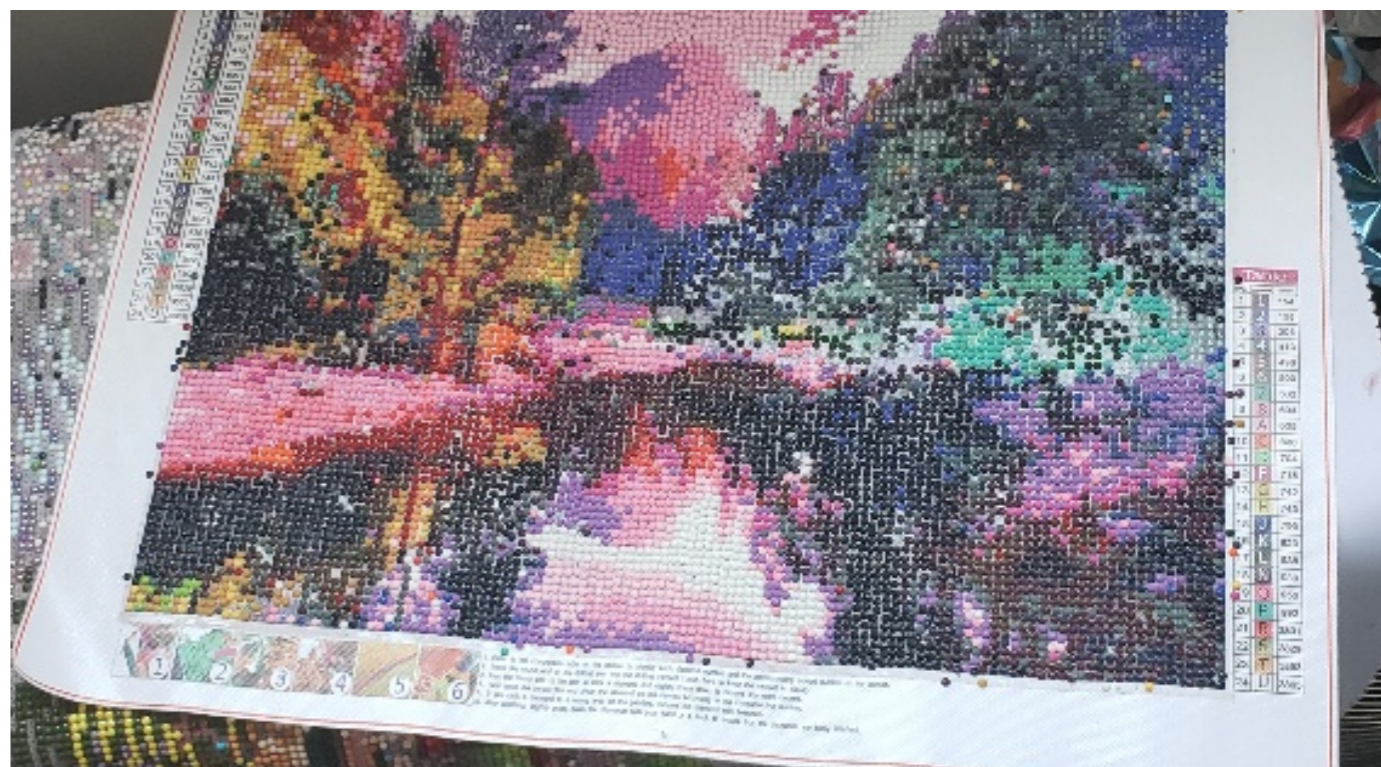

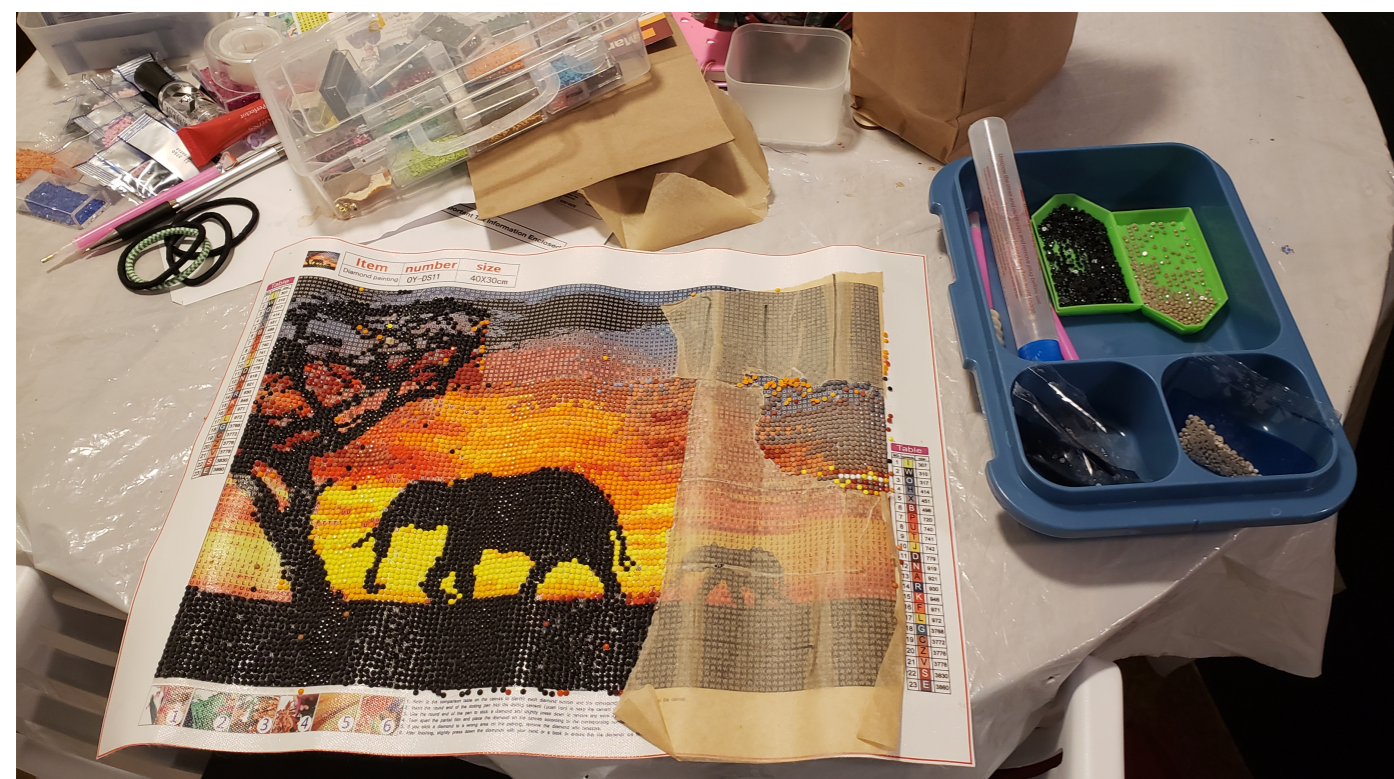


Diamond bead paintings - requiring complete focus. putting the correct color of plastic bead on the correct tiny square to complete the picture.
